Additionally, he was awarded a PhD scholarship for distinguished students from the Economics Department at the University of Jordan.

Dr. Al-Tal participated as a member of the economic modernization vision team, which was held at the Royal Hashemite Court, in addition to his contribution to the preparation of the macroeconomic model for the vision. He has also held various tasks, including directing and supervising trainee projects at the Crown Prince Foundation, serving as a reviewer for several economic scientific journals, serving as a member of the research faculty at the Institute of Political and Social Sciences, supervising the University of Jordan's radio station, and previously working as an economic researcher, official spokesperson, and secretary of the Anti-Corruption and Integrity Commission.
