#### A- Aims:

The second part provides candidates with a brief outline of the financial statements, and introduces the main financial ratios.

The third part examines the behaviour and determinants of some of the main financial ratios.

The fourth part concludes the course by examining the concept of "Economic profit".

- 1. Understand the importance of finance in financial analysis.
- 2. Understand the meaning of the main financial ratios and what affects their behaviour.
