



Two distinguished UJ researchers and faculty members were recently honored by the University after being awarded the Abdul Hameed Shoman Award for Arab Researchers 2014.

Dr. Tareq Hussien and Dr. Mutaz Al-Debei received a commemorative gift from UJ President Prof. Ekhleif Tarawneh in presence of Vice President Prof. Musa Al lozi.

Dr. Tareq Hussien who won the Applied Sciences award, Impact of climate change on the environment category, is an Associate Professor at the Faculty of Science.
